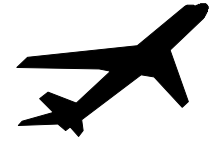


“Der Innotranser”

Over the years **Innotrans** has become established as **THE** major event in the railway industry. Every two years manufacturers have the opportunity to show off their latest products to Railway companies in what has become a truly global event. At the end of the event, usually on the weekend, the event is open to the general public who have the opportunity to examine all the new products at first hand. In 2012 the exhibition takes place in Berlin, itself a major railway hub with its vast s-bahn network and massive stations making it an excellent location. We will however be based in Magdeburg in order to keep costs down. ITINERARY

Day One - Thursday 20th September

Arrival day and if you are flying into Berlin, Magdeburg is around a two hour journey. You should aim to arrive late afternoon as we intend to visit BW Rothensee in the early evening. For those of you who have visited Magdeburg with us before, the hotel overlooks the station and the freight trains run through the night – but do try and get some sleep we have a busy few days

Day Two - Friday 21st September

After allowing time for the morning rush hour we take to the rails and head to Leipzig. Here we will visit **Bw Engelsdorf**, **Bw Lepzip West** and **Bw Leipzig Sud**. We then head west and the short journey to Halle where we visit both the passenger depot **Bw Halle P** and the freight depot **Bw Halle G**. We then have a choice of observing the evening rush at Leipzig or Halle with its passing freight trains before returning to Magdeburg.

Day Three - Saturday 22nd September

This morning we take the train to Berlin and directly to **Berlin Messe Sud** for the **Innotrans** exhibition. Here we will allow a good few hours to see all the exhibits and perhaps pick up a few souvenir goody bags. In the afternoon we will visit Bw **Seddin** and **BW Lichtenberg** before returning to Magdeburg.

Day Four - Sunday 23rd September

We head west today with visits to **BW Braunschweig** and **BW Seelze** which should both be well stacked on a Sunday. We will then spend some time in Hannover at the Hauptbahnhof before returning to Magdeburg.

Day 5 - Monday 24th September

Our final day and time for another rush hour session. However it would be quite impolite to leave Magdeburg so early, so please arrange a late flight so that you can join us for a visit to **BW Magdeburg Buchau**. After this it really will be time to leave yet another enjoyable tour
